Dear EES families,



While in school, your child attends technology class once a week where he/she is learning how to use various programs on the school laptops. Some of these programs require sound. In order to utilize the sound feature, we are providing the following options for students at EES: Students may use a shared pair of headphones that is purchased by the school and kept in the technology classrooms; students may bring their own pair of headphones/ear buds from home (to be labeled and kept in their classroom during the school year), or they may purchase a pair from school for **\$8.60**. A picture of the pair they will be buying is shown above.

By bringing in or purchasing his/her own headphones, we aim to help prevent spreading any communicable diseases, such as head lice. The headphones available for purchase for your child should be stored in a zip lock bag in their classroom and brought to technology class weekly and used whenever needed to access laptops and/or iPads in school. Elkridge Elementary is not responsible for broken or missing headphones.

If a replacement is needed, they may be purchased from the front office of school for the remainder of the year or a shared pair may be borrowed for the day.
